## TECHNICAL SERVICES GROUP

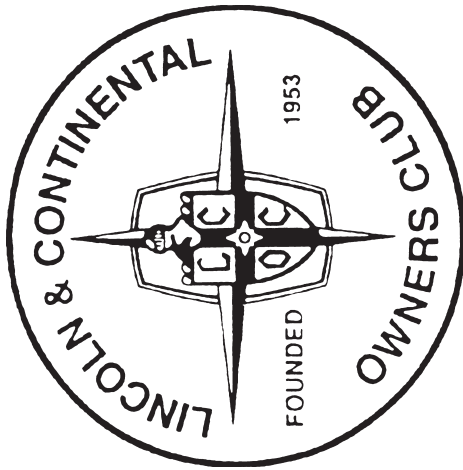

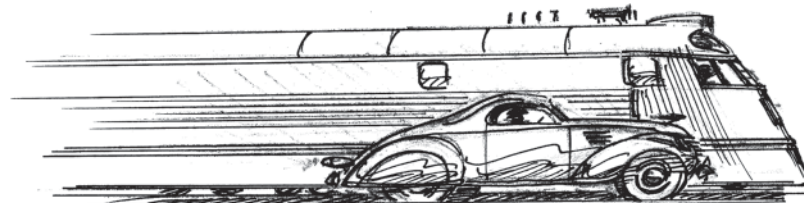
